The following ships, which entered Antarctic waters in 2009/2010, made meteorological reports, they may have reported from outside Antarctic waters after the date given here. For most ships the 2009 season begins in November or December. Country is the country of recruitment to the VOS, or where not known of registration. Those that were in Antarctic waters and made observations during the January SMM are indicated by M. Latest obs in brackets indicate these are outside Antarctica.
