

**BRITISH ANTARCTIC SURVEY IMMUNISATION  
REQUIREMENT**

The BASMU immunisation policy explains all the background as to why BASMU expect all staff deploying to Polar remote regions to have the following inoculations. *Your GP will hold a record of your immunisation status and be able to provide the dates requested.*

**For everyone**

**Diphtheria / Tetanus / Polio.**

A combined vaccine. Booster every 10years up to maximum of 5 courses.

**Meningitis ACWY**

Single dose. Booster every 5 years to age 35.

**MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)**

A combined vaccine, one course.

**For those who wish to have the vaccine (an individuals choice)**

**Yellow Fever**

Recommended by the authorities who operate the Brize Norton (UK) – Ascension Island – Falkland Islands air route in case of aircraft diversion. Not mandatory, down to individual choice

NOT required for Arctic work.

**For certain people as advised**

**BCG (Tuberculosis)**

If screening information highlights this requirement.

**Hepatitis A**

For workers exposed to raw sewage.

**Hepatitis B**

For some health care workers.

**Rabies**

For staff travelling through high risk rabies areas on the way to and from Polar regions.
